What is Baptism?

Baptism is a public profession of your faith in Jesus Christ. If you have accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior, then you're ready to be baptized!

"Those who believe and accepted the message were baptized." Acts 2:41

What Does the Bible Say about Baptism?

Jesus was baptized, so by getting baptized, we're following his example.

'At that time Jesus came from Nazareth . . . and was baptized by John in the Jordan [River]. Mark 1:9

Jesus commanded that his followers be baptized.

"[Jesus said,] 'Go then, to all people everywhere and make them my disciples, baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you.'" Matthew 28:19-20

Baptism is your public declaration of faith in Jesus.

". . . many of the Corinthians who heard believed and were baptized." Acts 18

Getting baptized shows that you know Jesus on a personal level.

"We know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments." 1 John 2:3

Do I Have to Get Baptized in the Church?

No. You can get baptized now, wherever you are! You just need water. Anyone that has a personal relationship with Jesus can baptize you. If you've made that decision, we would love to hear from you!

What Are the Steps for Baptism?

- Talk with a friend, family member, or mentor who has a relationship with Jesus about baptizing you.
- Plan on a time and place for your baptism.
- Invite your family and friends to witness the celebration.
- Share your story.
- Whoever baptizes you can ask you "if you've made the decision to accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior." Then you would respond, "yes". They would then "baptize you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit." (That's when they lower you under the water.)
